May Traffic Report

Robert J. Sweeney, Executive Secretary of the Mackinac Bridge Authority, reported today that 309,549 vehicles crossed the Mackinac Bridge during the month of May. This represents a 6.6 percent decrease when compared to the 331,497 crossings during May 2007.

Fare revenue for the month of May was up 9.7 percent and 6.3 percent for the year, compared to 2007. This increase is due to the recent toll restructuring that was implemented on March 1, 2008.

Mr. Sweeney reported that construction activity is in full swing at the Mackinac Bridge. He asks that travelers drive with extreme caution during the construction season, slow down, be aware of our construction workers, and "Give 'em a Brake".
